

Financial Aid & Final Payment – UCLA Students

How do UCLA students apply for Global Internship Program Financial Aid?

Step 1

- **Submit** the "**GIP Agreement For Financial Aid Recipients**" form on your application portal
- **Due:** February 10, 2025

Step 2

- **Submit** the [FAFSA/California Dream Act](#) application
- **Open:** December 1, 2024
- **Due:** March 3, 2025

Step 3

- **View** the mandatory "**Financial Aid webinar**" on your application portal
- **Attend** live Q &A sessions with the Financial Aid Office
- **Read** the "**Financial Aid Guide**" in your application portal

Step 4

- **Check** [MyUCLA](#) for required supplemental documentation under "Financial Aid Document Tracking"
- **Submit** requested items right away to avoid delaying your FAN and financial aid disbursements
- **Accept** your FAN as soon as possible and if offered loans, be sure to complete the necessary documentation right away. Please note that a Parent Plus loan requires your parents to apply and submit additional documentation

Step 5

- **Logon** to [MyUCLA](#) to make sure your financial aid has been disbursed
- **Pay** remaining balance (if necessary) before the start of your program

<p>■ REGARDLESS OF YOUR AID PACKAGE, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING THE FULL PROGRAM FEE AFTER FEBRUARY 12, 2025.</p>	<p>■ Financial aid should disburse to BruinBill 5-10 days prior to your program start date. Make sure to clear any holds and submit required paper work to ensure timely disbursement of financial aid funds.</p>
<p>■ Continuing UCLA students who are eligible for aid during the academic year are typically eligible for summer aid. Aid packages take into consideration the full program cost, including the program fee, as well as the estimated costs for airfare, local transportation, meals and incidentals.</p>	<p>■ Please contact the UCLA Financial Aid Office through the message center on MyUCLA for questions regarding your financial aid.</p>
<p>■ Students must be enrolled in 8 units to be UCLA Financial Aid eligible.</p>	<p>■ Grants are extremely limited in summer, so be prepared for a financial aid package that consists PRIMARILY of loans, including Parent Plus and private loans.</p>
